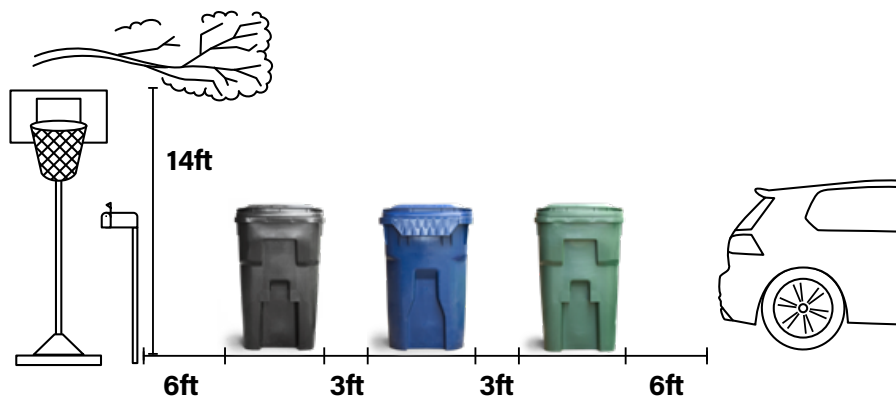
SERVICES GUIDE



CART SET-OUT

To receive service:

- **Carts at the curb** with handle facing your residence by 6:00AM, including holidays. Do not block sidewalks.
- **Carts need their space.** Place carts –
 - **3 feet** away from other carts.
 - **6 feet** away from cars, boats, and other obstacles.
 - away from tree limbs/utility wires, etc., with **14 feet** of overhead clearance to empty cart into collection truck.
- **Cart lids must be closed.** Avoid littering your neighborhood.



To keep streets clear and improve the appearance of your neighborhood, return carts to your property after service.

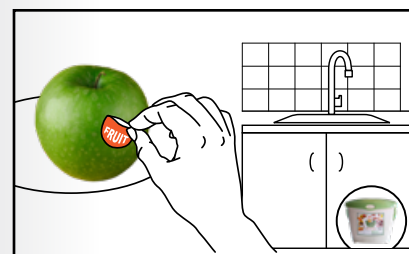

HOW TO COLLECT FOOD SCRAPS AND FOOD-SOILED PAPER:



Collect food scraps and food-soiled paper in a bowl, recycled container, or kitchen pail lined with a paper bag or towel, newspaper, or compostable bag (**BPI Certified/ASTM D6400**).



Drain liquid from food scraps. Remove stickers, twist ties, rubber bands, and plastic wrap. Store kitchen container in convenient location (under sink, on counter top, or in refrigerator or freezer).



Frequently empty kitchen container into your Organics cart to avoid odor and pests.

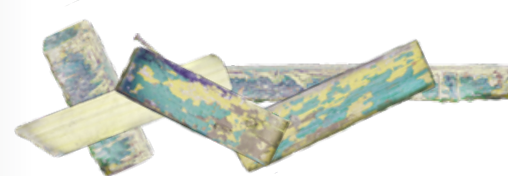

BULKY WASTE PICKUP

ONE PICKUP EVERY 12 MONTHS IS INCLUDED IN YOUR RATE. ADDITIONAL PICKUPS ARE AVAILABLE FOR A FEE.



Pile size limited to 5 cubic yards/8'x4'x4', i.e., pickup truck bed loaded to the top of cab. Larger piles, subject to added fees. Keep bulky waste 6 feet from stationary objects.

ACCEPTED FOR PICKUP:

- ✓ Items too large for garbage cart (Furniture, mattresses, etc.)
- ✓ Pipes, lumber, tree/shrub trimmings (not to exceed 4"x5')
- ✓ Appliances*
- ✓ E-waste* (TVs/computers/cell phones, etc.)
- ✓ Tires* (no rims; 5 maximum)
- ✓ Fluorescent tubes* (4 feet or less)

*Place these items to the side of your pile.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

- ⊘ No heavy material (rocks, dirt, tree stumps, etc.)
- ⊘ No glass panes/mirrors
- ⊘ No household hazardous waste (batteries, chemicals, oil, paint, propane tanks, treated wood waste, etc.)
- ⊘ No liquids

USED OIL AND USED OIL FILTERS PICKUP

USED MOTOR OIL, USED OIL FILTERS, AND COOKING OIL ARE COLLECTED WEEKLY, THE SAME DAY AS GARBAGE/ORGANICS.



- Place used oil in rigid or semi-rigid plastic one-gallon containers with screw-top lids; or
- Reuse the original screw-top plastic oil containers; and
- Securely tape all lids.
- Maximum limit per collection day is 3 gallons.
- Oil filters must be drained and placed in a sealed plastic bag.
- Place used motor oil, used oil filters, and cooking oil at the curb **3 feet** away from carts.

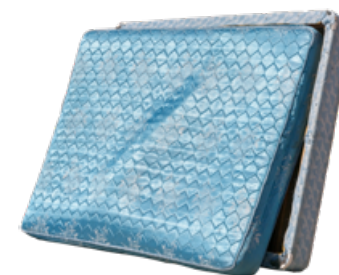

OLIVIA ORGANICS

- Collects Organics such as food scraps, food-soiled paper, and yard trimmings.
- Puts them in the Organics cart to make beneficial compost.
- Helps reduce methane emissions.
- Saves landfill space.

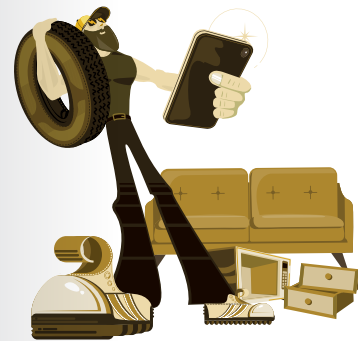
ROBBIE RECYCLE

- Recycles right. Puts empty and dry recyclables loose in the Recycling cart. Does not bag recyclables.
- Recycles items like glass bottles, metal cans, newspaper, flattened cardboard, water bottles, yogurt containers and hard plastics.
- Lids and labels ok.



OSCAR OIL

- Recycles oil right.
- Never puts used oil or filters in any collection cart.
- Never pours on the ground or in storm drains.
- Follows curbside collection set out guidelines.



BULKY BEN

- Reduces landfill waste by reusing, recycling or donating usable bulky items.
- To get rid of broken-down bulky waste items, schedules a Bulky Waste Pickup appointment.
