



SECURE YOUR LOAD! IT'S THE LAW.

Why does California State Vehicle Code require loads be properly covered or secured?

Litter And Debris From Unsecured Loads Is:

- Unlawful
- Unsightly
- Dangerous To Other Drivers
- Ends Up In Local Waterways
- Harms Wildlife
- Contaminates Our Environment



Violations can result in fines for both unsecured loads and littering - CA State Vehicle Code Sections 23114.(a), 23115.(a) and CA Penal Code 374.3(a-j) -

How to properly secure your load:

- Put lighter weight items at the bottom
- Use tarps, straps, rope, bungee cords, nets
- Tie larger items directly to your vehicle
- Don't overload your vehicle



Remember! Unsecured loads are also subject to \$25 fee.

Prevent littering on site! Do not remove tarps until reaching the tipping area.
